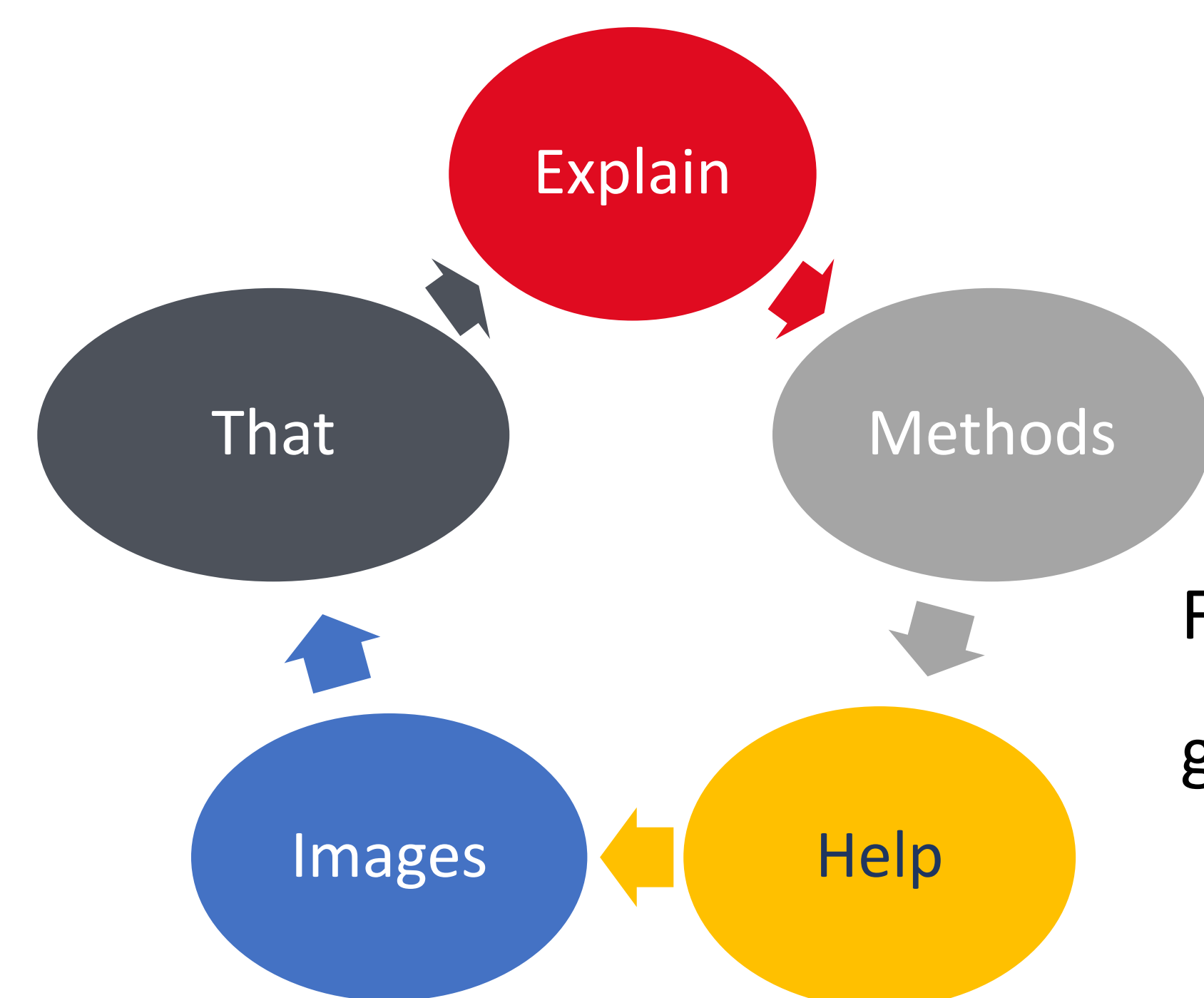


Figure 1. Sample graphic

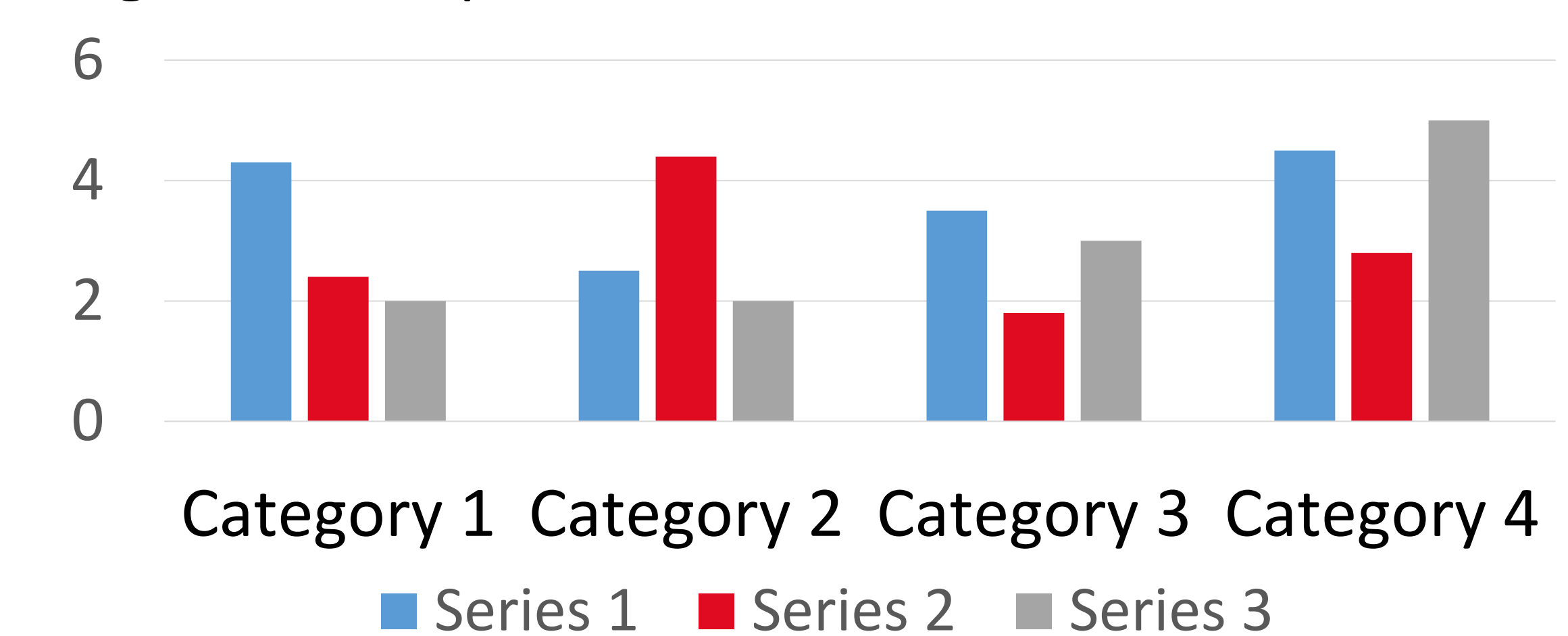
